Second cycle

Second-cycle courses and study programmes shall be based fundamentally on the knowledge acquired by students during first-cycle courses and study programmes, or its equivalent. Second-cycle courses and study programmes shall involve the acquisition of specialist knowledge, competence and skills in relation to first-cycle courses and study programmes, and in addition to the requirements for first-cycle courses and study programmes shall:

- further develop the ability of students to integrate and make autonomous use of their knowledge,
- develop the students' ability to deal with complex phenomena, issues and situations, and
- develop the students' potential for professional activities that demand considerable autonomy, or for research and development work.

National qualitative targets of Specialist Nursing degrees in the Higher Education Ordinance*

Outcomes: For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing the student shall demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to work autonomously as a specialist nurse.

Knowledge and understanding

- demonstrate knowledge of the disciplinary foundation of the field and insight into current research and development work as well as the links between research and proven experience and the significance of these links for professional practice, and
- demonstrate specialised knowledge of the planning, management and coordination of healthcare measures.

Competence and skills

- demonstrate specialised skills in identifying healthcare needs and drawing up care programmes autonomously and in collaboration with the patient and those close to them
- demonstrate the ability to direct and evaluate healthcare interventions
- demonstrate specialised skills in initiating, undertaking and evaluating health promotion and preventive interventions
- demonstrate the ability to integrate knowledge and also to analyse, assess and deal with complex issues and situations
- demonstrate the ability to participate in or undertake autonomously examinations and treatment, including palliative care, and
- demonstrate the capacity to act as a nursing instructor.

Judgement and approach

- demonstrate self-awareness and the capacity for empathy
- demonstrate the ability to assess interventions using a holistic approach to individuals informed by the relevant disciplinary, social and ethical aspects and taking particular account of human rights
- demonstrate the ability to adopt a professional approach to patients and those close to them, and
- demonstrate the ability to identify the need for further knowledge and undertake ongoing development of his or her skills.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Anaesthesia Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to take responsibility for monitoring and undertaking local and general anaesthetic, analgesic and sedative interventions in connection with surgical operations, examinations and the treatment of patients, and
- demonstrate the ability to apply his or her specialist knowledge in connection with major accidents and catastrophes.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Intensive Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe and assess the functions of all organic systems and the mental condition of patients as well as the ability to initiate and undertake medical interventions autonomously, and
- demonstrate the ability to apply his or her specialist knowledge in connection with major accidents and catastrophes.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Theatre Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to take responsibility for asepsis, instruments and measures to prevent infection and complications in connection with surgical interventions and the treatment and examination of patients as well as the ability to manage biological specimens, and
- demonstrate the ability to apply his or her specialist knowledge in connection with major accidents and catastrophes.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Pre-Hospital Emergency Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to assess the somatic or mental status and immediate needs of sick or injured individuals and also demonstrate the ability to undertake the interventions required for patients in widely differing circumstances, and
- demonstrate the ability to apply his or her specialist knowledge in connection with major accidents and catastrophes.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Surgical Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with complex nursing needs in patients requiring surgical care.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Medical Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with complex nursing needs in patients undergoing medical care.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Oncology Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with complex nursing needs in patients requiring oncology care, and
- demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to work with treatments such as cytostatic therapy and radiotherapy.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Paediatric Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to assess, plan, undertake and evaluate the interventions required to promote physical, mental and social health and prevent the occurrence of illnesses and their complications autonomously
- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with complex care needs in children and young people at different stages of development, and
- demonstrate the knowledge required to take responsibility for health examinations and vaccinations.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Mental Health Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with complex care needs
- demonstrate the ability to deal with individuals in crisis, and
- demonstrate the knowledge and skills required to participate in treatment, habilitation and rehabilitation in mental health nursing and care.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Elderly Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to assess, plan, undertake and evaluate the measures required to promote physical, mental and social health and prevent the occurrence of illnesses and their complications autonomously, and
- demonstrate the ability to observe and assess complex care and rehabilitation needs in elderly patients.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing: Primary Health Care the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to assess, plan, undertake and evaluate the interventions required to promote physical, mental and social health and prevent the occurrence of illnesses and their complications autonomously
- demonstrate the ability to observe and assess complex care, habilitation and rehabilitation needs in patients, and
- demonstrate the knowledge required to take responsibility for health examinations and vaccinations.

For a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing with another specific specialisation the student shall also

- demonstrate the ability to observe, assess and deal with care needs, habilitation and rehabilitation in patients within the specific area of specialisation autonomously
- demonstrate the ability to plan, undertake and evaluate measures required for different illnesses, to promote health and prevent the occurrence of illnesses and their complications in the specific area of specialisation
- demonstrate the ability to take responsibility for examinations and treatment in the specific area of specialisation, and
- demonstrate the ability to apply his or her specialist knowledge and skills in caring situations and for target groups that are particularly relevant for the specific area of specialisation.

A requirement for the award of a Postgraduate Diploma in Specialist Nursing is completion by the student of an independent project (degree project).
